Grosmont is a peaceful village in the Esk Valley containing a very famous rail route from Whitby to Pickering. You can visit world's oldest passenger railway tunnel, built by railway pioneer George Stephenson. There is also a 3.5-mile Rail Trail runs up Stephenson's original railway line from Grosmont, via Beck Hole, to Goathland - great for walkers with scenic views. There is a pub and cafés, one being at the station itself. Visit
