What's on?

York is a vibrant city rich in ancient history with a range of fun and insightful activities. Why not give the home of chocolate a visit? At York's Chocolate Story you can learn the host of surprising secrets and fascinating facts behind York's greatest chocolate products, from the Chocolate Orange to the globally famous Kit Kat. You can then get hands on and create your own chocolate bar to take home. If you're a little more daring why not explore the dungeons and be taken through 2000 years of York's eyrie history with full on authenticity and theatrical storytelling.

However, if neither of these unusual options are for you there are more traditional attractions. York Minster is a world-class cathedral benefitting from 275 steps up the Central Tower leading you to the highest point in the city (listed as one of the History and Heritage Experiences in Visit England's '101 things to do before you go abroad'). The 'Shambles' are also a must-see; there are endless amounts of shops and exquisite cocktail bars to relax after a long day shopping. Cut the hassle of city driving by using the Park & Ride Service from as little as £3.80 per day with a free bus straight into the centre of York (for more information visit www.yorkparkandride.co.uk).

Directions:

- From Welbury, head east towards Shire Garth (230 ft) and continue for (184 ft)
- Turn right onto Tofts Lane (0.4 miles) then turn left (1.0 miles)
- Turn left onto Low Moor Lane (449 ft) and stay slightly right (85 ft)
- Turn right at the 1st cross street (0.8 miles) then turn left (1.4 miles)
- Turn right onto A19 (12.0 miles)
- Merge onto York Rd/A19 via the slip road to York and continue to follow A19 (8.1 miles)
- At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay on A19 (2.5 miles)
- At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay on A19 (9.0 miles)
- At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Shipton Rd/A19 and continue to follow A19 (2.3 miles)
- Continue onto St Leonard's Pl/A1036 (0.1 miles) and turn right onto Museum St/A1036
- Continue to follow A1036 (0.1 miles) until you arrive at York
